- 4) Approve minutes from meeting held 14th July 2022

- 5) Matters Arising
 - Cllr M Watson enquired if the keys for filing cabinets in the hall had been found; not been found yet.
- 6) Update from County Councillor Geoff Morgan
 - Cllr Morgan was under the impression that the refuse collections were sorted but it wasn't the case. There are many staff shortages throughout the department, of which PCC are trying to recruit for immediately. Areas effected tended to be within towns. Cllr Morgan advised that the Air Ambulance base could be moving to North Wales. Councillors agreed it would be detrimental to Mid Wales, as the service is used to often. Cllr G Morgan suggested the community council could write a letter to the appropriate parties to voice their opinion. *Clerk to write.* Following this, Cllr Morgan asked the council for their opinion on why there are so many accidents on our local trunk roads at the moment.
